


If you are **importing** an Illustrator file that you **exported** from Rhino, you will want to paste it over into a **NEW** Illustrator file (or your created board file) so you have an entire selection of colors in your color palette. When pasting into another Illustrator file, make sure **Paste Remember Layers** is selected. You have to click the more options button to get this sub-menu to appear.



When you create a NEW Illustrator file your settings for your boards should look similar to the window pictured here, and your layout should be something similar to image below, depending on how you decided to setup your boards.


